FRANCE WINE AND GASTRONOMIC TOURS

These tours will be linked and connected in unique and characteristic wine itineraries to enjoy the hidden secrets of the prestigious French wine.







DAY 1: PARIS, REIMS

Arrival in Paris.

Pick up at Paris airport by your private driver & transfer to Reims.

Transfer to Reims for a guided walking tour of the city. Reims offers the most important example in France of an entire town in the architectural style of the 1920s with its Art Deco style facades: wandering through the streets and discover the city of coronation and one of the main gastronomic and Champagne wine centres of France. Enjoy a visit of its **Notre Dame Cathedral**, a masterpiece of Gothic art dates from the 13th century as a reminder of the christening of Clovis. Adorned with over 2,300 statues, this is the only cathedral that displays angels with open wings.

Then you will enjoy a visit & a wine-tasting at a champagne house. For a while, take a dip into the heart of their House, their heritage, their « savoir-faire ». And discover the making-process of their cuvées. The tour includes a tasting of their Brut Yellow Label cuvée.

Your tour continues through another vineyard. This journey will lead you in turn to the vestiges of the **abbey Saint-Nicaise** dating from the 13th century, then to 18 meters deep, in sumptuous Gallo-Roman Crayères forming part of the Coteaux, Houses and Caves of Champagne Inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List. At the end of your visit, you will appreciate a prestigious wine tasting.

Transfer & settle into your hotel in Reims. Welcome dinner & overnight at your hotel.

Settle at you 4-star Hotel de la Paix for 2 nights B&B in Reims.

Overnight at your hotel.

DAY 2: REIMS, HAUTVILLERS

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by your private driver and departure to Reims Mountains.

Today you will discover the champagne path through the vineyards of the Reims Mountains.

Lunch in a local restaurant.

Enjoy a Guided tour of Hautvillers, a charming village classified at Unesco which is nested on the historical hillsides of Champagne. Discover the history of **Dom Perignon** who finalized the process to elaborate Champagne.

Continue to Epernay capital of champagne with its Avenue **du Champagne**, headquarter of the major wine-maker trade and production. This magnificent street is considered as one of the most world prestigious Avenues. Enjoy the visit of the cellars of Moet & Chandon with tasting. Back to Reims.

Overnight in Reims.

DAY 3: REIMS, BEAUNE

Breakfast at your hotel and check-out.

Pick up at your hotel by your private driver and departure. Crossing the champagne vineyards with visit and tasting of champagne grand vineyards in a small producer. This **Family Estate** is a wine grower since the 16th century and producing Champagne under their own brand since 1875. Far from the commercial aspect of the Grandes Maisons you will discover here the ancestral methods for the making process of champagne and meet passionate people.

Stop in the historic center of Troyes.

Continue towards Burgundy with stop in Chablis for visit and wine tasting in Chateau Testut.

Transfer to Beaune.

Settle at your 3-star Hotel La Belle Epoque for 3 nights B&B in Beaune.

Overnight in Beaune.

DAY 4: BEAUNE

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by your private driver and departure for the route of the vineyards of cotes de nuits. Today you will discover the Grand Crus of Bourgogne. Stop at a small producer to visit the cave and wine tasting Chateau Entredeux-Monts in Nuits Saint Georges.

Lunch in a gastronomic restaurant in Romanée.

After lunch, walk to the mythical Romanée Conti vineyard. Then you will visit the **Clos Vougeot**, former cellar of the Cistercian monks. Discover the ancient winemaking facilities and the monk's cellar, constructed between the 12th and 16th centuries.

Back to Beaune.

Overnight in Beaune.

DAY 5: BEAUNE

Breakfast at your hotel.

Meet your private guide at your hotel. (2hours services) Today enjoy a guided tour in the medieval town of **Beaune** with visit to the famous Hospices de Beaune (hotel Dieu),

built in the 15th century XV.
Then go to a **guided visit** of a traditional **Mustard Factory** Fallot with tasting. Endowed with a successful industrial facilities, it knew how to protect the know-how of the craftsman mustardmaker; the grinding of seeds in the stony grindstone which protects all the gustative qualities

Enjoy a tour to the north of the Côte de Beaune. Stop off on the Corton hillside, a unique location in Burgundy for red and white Grands Crus. Then visit & tasting at the Château de Santenay.

Overnight in Beaune.



DAY 6: BEAUNE, LYON

Breakfast at your hotel and check-out

Pick-up at your hotel by your private qualified Spanish driver and route through the vineyards of southern Borgogna and Beaujolais.

Enjoy a visit and wine tasting in Chateau Montmelas. The beautiful outline of this castle is made up of numerous turrets, which is why it's often called Sleeping Beauty's castle, especially since it is surrounded by 70 ha of vineyard in the Beaujolais Appellation. You will visit the interior of the château with tapestry and furniture.

Then you enjoy a **Buffet lunch** of Beaujolais Specialties: "Machons" in Chateau Montmelas.

After lunch transfer to **Lyon**, capital of French gastronomy. Meet your local qualified Spanish speaking guide and enjoy a walking tour of Lyon. Visit to the Basilica **Notre Dame de Fourviere** and discover the quarter of Vieux Lyon considered a UNESCO world heritage site.

Settle at your 4-star boutique hotel College hotel, for 1 night B&B.

Overnight in Lyon.

DAY7: LYON, CLERMONT-FERRAND, LIBOURNE

Breakfast at your hotel and check-out.

Pick up at your hotel by your private Spanish speaking driver and transfer to Libourne. Route through the central Magico and the park of volcanoes with its magnificent mountainous landscapes.

Stop in the historic medieval center of **Clermont Ferrand**. Visit on your own the Cathedral which is distinctive by its charcoal grey colour resulting from the Volvic lava stone used to build it. The interior conceals a remarkable collection of stained-glass windows and murals. Discover **Notre-Dame-du-Port Basilica**, listed on **UNESCO's World** Heritage, which takes visitors into the spellbinging world of Romanesque art.

Continue to the region of Aquitaine.

In the late afternoon arrival in **Puisseguin Saint Emilion** to visit the cellar and garden of the Chateau de la Vaisinerie

followed by a typical harmonized **dinner**. Settle at your 4-star **Hotel Mercure Libourne Saint Emilion**, for 1 night B&B.

Overnight in Libourne.

DAY 8: LIBOURNE, BORDEAUX

Breakfast at your hotel and check-out. Pick up by your private driver and departure.

Discovery of the wine route of Medoc, through the famous vineyards of Margaux, Saint Estephé, Saint Julien, Pauillac. Stop at **two grands vineyards** Classes of 1855 for a visit of the cellar with wine tasting (Château Lynch Bages, Château Giscours, Château Pontet Canet (...) or similar). Transfer to **Cité du vin** in **Bordeaux.**

Discover Cité du Vin, a new unique cultural facility where wine comes to life through an immersive, sensorial approach, all set within an **evocative architectural design**. Cité du Vin gives a **different view of wine**, across the world, across the ages, across all cultures and all civilisations.

Enjoy a panoramic tour in Bordeaux.

Bordeaux UNESCO heritage; from the vestige of the middle ages, to the elegance of the 18th century, you will discover the different golden ages of Bordeaux's history, dominated by the wine trade and various colonial in-

Settle in you 4-star **boutique hotel Hotel de Sèze** in triangle d'or of Bordeaux, for 2 nights B&B. Overnight in Bordeaux.

DAY 9: BORDEAUX

Breakfast at your hotel.

You will appreciate a private cruise through the heart of the estuary and stopover on Patiras island.

Enjoy the musical atmosphere and taste speciali-

ties from the Gironde estuary. You will discover the view of islands, sailing channels, Médoc vineyards, as well as the history of the people who used to live on the islands.

Today, Patiras also invites you to relax in a deckchair and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of the island.

Overnight at your hotel.

DAY 1: BORDEAUX

Arrival in Bordeaux.

Welcome by your driver and your guide.

Transfer to Bordeaux for a Panoramic tour of **Bordeaux UNESCO** heritage: from the vestige of the Middle Ages, to the elegance of the 18th century, you will discover the different golden ages of Bordeaux's history, dominated by the wine trade and various colonial influences.

Settle into your hotel.

Welcome dinner & overnight in Bordeaux.

DAY 2: MEDOC VINEYARDS

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by a private coach & your guide. Departure for the **Médoc** for a guided visit of the city. The most famous of the Bordeaux vineyards which lies to the North-West of Bordeaux city, a vast spit of land between the Atlantic Ocean to the West and the Gironde Estuary to the East. A geographical location that confers on it a temperate climate suited to wine-growing. This symbiosis of plant and environment has given 60 prestigious Grand Crus Classés and 400 Crus Bourgeois in the 8 AOC of the Médoc. During your tour you will have **three visits and wine tastings** at prestigious vineyards and wineries in **Pauillac, Margaux & Saint-Julien** wine appellations of Origin (AOC). Lunch in a typical restaurant to discover the Médoc gastronomy. These places are immersed in a remarkable views of vineyards landscapes and they are based on soils which have been laboured and transformed by the winemakers' industry and savoir-faire like the distinguished. Back to & overnight at the hotel in Bordeaux.

DAY 3: SAINT-ÉMILION, POMEROL

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by a private coach & your guide. Transfer to **Saint-Émilion** for a guided visit of the city. According to UNESCO 'the Jurisdiction of Saint-Émilion is an outstanding example of an historic vineyard landscape that has survived intact and is in activity to the present day'. Enjoy a visit and a unique lunch-buffet in a prestigious **Château.** Your tour pursues with one **visit and wine tasting** at Grand Cru Classé **Saint-Émilion** vineyards and the last visit in the **Pomerol** Appellation.

Back to & overnight at your hotel in Bordeaux.

Pick up at your hotel by your driver & guide and transfer to the **Côte de Beaune**. Walk around the city, capital of the Cote d'Or, in its medieval quarter, courtyards of private mansions. Guided visit of the **Hotel Dieu**, also called **Hospice of Beaune**, a masterpiece of Flemish – Burgundian architecture. It is a former charitable almshouse and has now become a museum. Continue the day by enjoying the visit of a **family domain** in the **Montrachet** Grand Cru Appellation. This domain has been owned for three generations by a Burgundian family. They will explain wine-growing techniques as well as offer an enjoyable tasting-session. For lunch, enjoy an original Burgundy setting in a **Cellier**. Finish the day by a visit and tasting-session at **Santenay Domain**. Back to & overnight at your hotel in **Beaune**.

DAY 3: CÔTE DE NUITS

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by your driver & guide and departure for the **Côte de Nuits**. Start the day by a visit of a **dairy farm** in Brochon and enjoy **tasting different cheeses**, from the mildest to the strongest in fla-vour.

For lunch, enjoy an outstanding **gourmet meal** with delicious dishes in an amazing domain! Of course prestigious wines will accompany your lunch.


Continue into the heart of the **Pinot Noir Grands Crus vineyards** of Gevrey Chambertin. Learn about the unique Burgundian appellations. Visit and **wine-tasting** at one prestigious domain.

Transfer to **Dijon** train station.

Lyon is a city full of life, dotted with cobblestoned narrow streets and exquisite places to wine and dine. Admire the **St Jean Quarter**, stroll in the "traboules", covered narrow lanes crossing buildings from one street to the other, and the "hotels "particuliers", beautiful mansions built by Italian merchants in the 15th and 16th century. Settle into your hotel in **Lyon**.

Welcome dinner & overnight at your hotel.

DAY 2: CÔTES DU RHÔNE VINEYARDS

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by your driver.

Transfer to visit and discover the northern vineyards of Côtes du Rhône and its landscapes, as well as Ampuis, Condrieu, Côte Rôtie, and Tain l'Hermitage. Explore several domains and enjoying different wine tastings in these AOC areas. Visit a characteristic family estate and its magnificent vineyards in Côte-Rôtie where the winemaker will introduce the group to the cellar's care and treatment processes. Continue down to the Côtes du Rhône pursuing the aim to offer the best portrait of the 'terroir', and stop in the Maison Chapoutier, a winegrower and producer of the finest Rhône Valley appellations. Of course this fascinating day will be accompanied by a traditional lunch in a local restaurant. Transfer to Avignon. Settle into & overnight at your hotel.

DAY 3: CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, RASTEAU, GI-GONDAS, BEAUMES DE VENISE

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by your driver.

Transfer to Châteauneuf du Pape, one of the most impor-

tant wine appellation in Southern Rhône where grapes were first planted in the 14th century by the Avignon popes, for a **visit** & **wine tasting experience** in an ancient and renewed cellar: **Maison Ogier**. A delightful experience in learning about oaks, barrel making, seeing and comparing wine of the different terroirs. Then departure for another **two visits** and **wine tasting sessions** in **Rasteau** and **Gigondas** AOC. Be witnesses of the best wines sharing their history and different techniques. Enjoy a **buffet-lunch** with local specialities in Gigondas cellar. Your amazing day-tour ends with the last **visit** and **wine tasting experience** in **Beaumes de Venise** cellar and its vineyards. Back to & overnight at your hotel in **Avignon**.

DAY 4: AVIGNON & DEPARTURE

Breakfast at your hotel.

This morning enjoy a guided visit of **Avignon**. The skyline of Avignon is a magnificent urban landscape. Your tour continues with another **wine tasting** at **Maison Canard Duchêne.** The Canard-Duchêne signature perfectly befits its setting in Ludes. The park, with its centuries-old trees, magnificent views over the vineyards, vast residence hosting more than 6km of chalk-carved underground cellars, make this a truly unforgettable visit. Back to Reims and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 3: EPERNAY CAVES, PARIS

Breakfast at your hotel.

Pick up at your hotel by your driver and enjoy a visit of several different domains and cellars where the famous Champagne is produced. Located in the heart of the Champagne vineyards, **Epernay** is the capital of Champagne with its **Avenue du Champagne**, headquarter of the major wine-maker trade and production. This magnificent street is considered as one of the most world prestigious Avenues.

This morning your day enjoy **two visits & wine tasting** sessions in distinguished and ancient cellars learning about the production techniques, & the different types of wines. You will appreciate **two Grand cru tasting** at different vineyards.

The wine-growers will share their passion with the group and will be glad to answer any question.

Enjoy the **lunch** in one traditional restaurant in Epernay. Your tour continues with a **visit & cheese tasting** at **Meaux**. You will discover the different stages of the manufacture of Brie de Meaux, from the harvesting of milk to maturing in the cellar. Then you will understand the current stakes of this PDO cheese proudly represented by his Brotherhood. Transfer to Paris city center or airport.

DAY 1: BORDEAUX, ST-EMILION & SARLAT

Pick up at Bordeaux and transfer to Saint-Emilion. Guided **visit of St Emilion**, medieval city, UNESCO world heritage site and one of the centres of Bordeaux wine-making.

Visit and tasting to the Château Ferrand, Grand Cru classé of Saint Emilion.

Transfer to **Sarlat,** medieval town in a region known in France as the *Périgord Noir*. 


